Purpose

A Public Participation Plan (PPP) has been developed in accordance with 6 NYCRR 621.3(a)(3).

What is the Proposed Project?

Buffalo Biodiesel, Inc. is applying for a **6 NYCRR Part 360 Solid Waste Management Facility Permit** for its existing **Used Cooking Oil (UCO) and Yellow Grease Processing Facility** located at 225 Sawyer Avenue in the Town of Tonawanda.

The Facility has operated at this location since 2005 and receives UCO and yellow grease from restaurants and commercial food establishments for processing, storage, and transfer for use in biodiesel production.

To implement this permitting action, Buffalo Biodiesel, Inc. has submitted an application to NYSDEC for authorization under **6 NYCRR Subpart 361-8 – Used Cooking Oil and Yellow Grease Processing Facilities**

This fact sheet is provided to inform the public about the proposed permitting action and to involve the surrounding community in the NYSDEC review process.

Why does Buffalo Biodiesel, Inc. need a Solid Waste Management Facility Permit?

New York State updated its solid waste regulations to require permits for facilities that process or manage **used cooking oil and yellow grease**. Because Buffalo Biodiesel, Inc. processes quantities exceeding regulatory thresholds, a Part 360 permit is required to continue operating in compliance with NYSDEC regulations.

The purpose of the permit is to ensure proper handling, processing, storage, and transfer of UCO and yellow grease in a manner that protects public health, the environment, and the surrounding community.

How might the project affect the surrounding community?

As an existing operation, no construction impacts are anticipated.

Potential operational impacts that are reviewed by NYSDEC include:

- **Truck traffic:** Delivery and transport of UCO occur on established industrial routes along Sawyer Avenue.
- **Odors:** UCO processing tanks are managed with heating, phase separation, and housekeeping practices to minimize odors.
- **Noise:** Normal industrial operational noise is expected; the Facility is located within an industrial corridor.
- **Wastewater:** Process water is pretreated on site and discharged under a Town of Tonawanda Industrial Sewer Connection Permit.
- **Sludge management:** Sludge is dewatered and sent to an approved anaerobic digestion Facility.

The Facility is located within a **New York State–designated Disadvantaged Community (DAC)/Environmental Justice (EJ) Area**, and enhanced public participation is required to ensure that local residents have meaningful opportunities to participate in the review process.

How can I participate in the permit review process?

- **Attend the virtual public meeting** scheduled for **May 4th, 2026 at 6:00 pm** to learn about the project, ask questions, and express concerns.
- **Submit comments, questions, or concerns** to the project contact person by phone, email, or in writing (see below).
- **Participate in the NYSDEC public comment period** once the Notice of Complete Application (NOCA) has been issued.

¿Por qué Buffalo Biodiesel, Inc. necesita un Permiso de Manejo de Residuos Sólidos?

El Estado de Nueva York actualizó sus regulaciones de residuos sólidos para exigir permisos para instalaciones que procesan o manejan aceite de cocina usado y grasa amarilla.

Debido a que Buffalo Biodiesel, Inc. procesa cantidades que superan los umbrales regulatorios, se requiere un permiso Parte 360 para continuar operando en cumplimiento con las regulaciones de NYSDEC.

El propósito del permiso es garantizar el manejo, procesamiento, almacenamiento y transferencia adecuados del UCO y la grasa amarilla de manera que proteja la salud pública, el medio ambiente y la comunidad circundante.

¿Cómo podría el proyecto afectar a la comunidad circundante?

Como una operación existente, no se anticipan impactos de construcción.

Los posibles impactos operativos revisados por NYSDEC incluyen:

- **Tráfico de camiones:** Las entregas y transporte de UCO ocurren en rutas industriales establecidas a lo largo de Sawyer Avenue.
- **Olores:** Los tanques de procesamiento de UCO se manejan con calentamiento, separación de fases y prácticas de limpieza para minimizar olores.
- **Ruido:** Se espera un nivel de ruido industrial normal; la instalación está ubicada dentro de un corredor industrial.
- **Aguas residuales:** El agua de proceso se pretrata en el sitio y se descarga bajo un Permiso de Conexión de Alcantarillado Industrial del Municipio de Tonawanda.
- **Manejo de lodos:** El lodo se deshidrata y se envía a una instalación aprobada de digestión anaeróbica.

La instalación está ubicada dentro de un **Área Designada como Comunidad Desfavorecida (DAC) / Justicia Ambiental (EJ) por el Estado de Nueva York**, y se requiere participación pública mejorada para garantizar que los residentes locales tengan oportunidades significativas de participar en el proceso de revisión.
